

SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities)

Intent

At Crosby-on-Eden School we offer an inclusive education to all our children.

We aim to maximise the potential of all our children, whatever their ability by providing an accessible, broad and balanced curriculum, covering all areas of the EYFS and National Curriculum, setting high expectations.

Implementation

We provide quality first teaching to all of our children and support this with individual plans for children who have special educational needs or disabilities.

We assess all children's needs and provide early interventions. We seek external support, where necessary and implement the advice of experts and professional involved from outside of the school. We assess children and follow a plan, do, review schedule once assessments are completed and discussed with parents and children.

Children who are experiencing Special Educational Needs are catered for as individuals, in small groups and by whole class, quality first teaching.

Approaches are adapted to need, removing barriers to achievement, enabling all children to flourish and achieve their potential.

We ensure that the needs of pupils with SEND are identified early.

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Impact

By the end of their time at Crosby on Eden children are prepared for their next steps in education and as part of a wider community. Children achieve their potential and develop their talents, making good progress from their starting points.
